

# Cute and Easy Vinyl Projects

## Mini Board Decor



### Supplies Provided in Kit

- Mini Wood Cutting Board
- StyleTech Craft Matte Black Vinyl “Happiness is Homemade”
- StyleTech Craft Burgundy Vinyl “hearts and swirl”
- StyleTech Craft Transfer tape
- Gwen Studios Black Satin Ribbon
- Sizzix Glue (from marker projects)
- Extra 6” x 6” uncut vinyl square of each color included

### Extra Supplies Needed

- Weeding tool
- Felt Edge Squeegee
- Scissors
- Xyron Hot glue (if desired)

## Kit Instructions

1. Weed out the sections of the black and burgundy vinyl leaving behind the words, swirl, and hearts.
2. Apply transfer tape on top of the black vinyl letters with the squeegee or your fingers, and pull up making sure all letters are stuck to the transfer tape.
3. Place the vinyl on the wood board in the center of the board and use the squeegee to stick the vinyl to the wood.
4. Pull off the transfer tape leaving the vinyl words on the board.
5. Repeat steps 2-4 with the burgundy hearts and swirl placing on the wood board in the correct alignment.
6. Tie a bow with the black ribbon in any size you of choosing, and glue in place at the neck of the cutting board.

## Cutting Instructions (for Cricut)

1. Place vinyl colors and type of your choice liner side down onto StandardGrip Mat.
2. Select the "Happiness is Homemade" SVG file into design space.
3. Size image to 3.7" wide by 2.7" tall and select "make it"
4. Select the vinyl setting for the type of vinyl you placed on your mat.
5. Load mat into the machine and press the flashing Go button.

## Craft Queen Keychain



## Supplies Provided in Kit

- Clear Acrylic circle
- Tassel
- Jump ring
- Keyring with chain
- StyleTechCraft Teal Transparent Glitter Vinyl "circle"
- StyleTechCraft Violet Craft Vinyl "Craft Queen"
- StyleTechCraft Coral Craft Vinyl "zigzag"
- Transfer tape
- Extra 6" x 6" uncut vinyl square of each color included

## Extra Supplies Needed

- Weeding tool
- Felt Edge Squeegee
- Pliers

## Kit Instructions

1. Pull off the protective layer from the acrylic keychain from both sides.
2. Weed out the sections of the teal, violet, and coral vinyl leaving behind the words, circle, and zigzag.
3. Apply transfer tape on top of the teal circle with the squeegee or your fingers, and pull up making sure the circle is stuck to the transfer tape.
4. Place the vinyl on the acrylic circle not covering up the hole at the top and use the squeegee to stick the vinyl to the wood.
5. Pull off the transfer tape leaving the vinyl circle on the acrylic.
6. Repeat steps 3-5 with the coral zigzag and then the violet words placing the acrylic in the correct alignment with the picture.
7. Attach the keyring chain and tassel to the acrylic circle with the jump ring and the pliers.

## Cutting Instructions (for Cricut)

1. Place vinyl colors and type of your choice liner side down onto StandardGrip Mat.
2. Select the "Craft Queen" SVG file into design space.
3. Size image to 1.6" wide by 1.6" tall and select "make it"
4. Select the vinyl setting for the type of vinyl you placed on your mat.
5. Load mat into the machine and press the flashing Go button.

## Smile There's Wine



### Supplies Provided in Kit

- Styletech Craft Mint Ultra Metallic Vinyl “Smile Wine”
- Styletech Craft Champagne Ultra Metallic Vinyl “there’s” and “stars”
- Styletech Craft Black Ultra Metallic vinyl “stars”
- StyleTech Craft Transfer tape
- Extra 6” x 6” uncut vinyl square of each color included

### Extra Supplies Needed

- Wine Glass
- Weeding tool
- Felt Edge Squeegee

### Kit Instructions

1. Clean the outside of the wine glass, it can be glass or plastic and any style you like. Make sure the glass is dry.
2. Weed out the sections of the mint, champagne, and black vinyl leaving behind the words and stars.
3. Apply transfer tape on top of the mint vinyl letters with the squeegee or your fingers, and pull up making sure all letters are stuck to the transfer tape.

4. Place the vinyl on the wine glass below the lip drinking line, about 1.5 inches from the edge and use the squeegee to stick the vinyl to the wine glass.
5. Pull off the transfer tape leaving the vinyl words on the glass.
6. Repeat steps 3-5 with the champagne words and stars and then lastly with the black stars placing on the glass in the correct alignment.

#### Cutting Instructions (for Cricut)

1. Place vinyl colors and type of your choice liner side down onto StandardGrip Mat.
2. Select the "Smile there's Wine" SVG file into design space.
3. Size image to 2.3" wide by 2" tall and select "make it"
4. Select the vinyl setting for the type of vinyl you placed on your mat.
5. Load mat into the machine and press the flashing Go button.
