Beautiful and Easy Layered Stencil Cards

Hello my Friend and Butterfly Kisses Cards



Supplies Provided in Kit

- TCW6049 A2 Butterfly Ferns Frame Stencil
- Catherine Pooler Lilac Ink
- Catherine Pooler Crushed Violet Ink
- Catherine Pooler Eucalyptus Ink
- (2) white A2 Card base and envelope
- (2) white 4.25 x 5.5 inch paper card layer (back)
- (2) white 4 x 5.25 inch paper card layer (front)
- (1) copy paper
- Sizzix Tape Runner

Extra Supplies Needed

- Blending brushes
- Washi tape
- Bone folder (optional)

Instructions

- 1. Tape down the front (smaller) card layer to the copy paper with washi tape.
- 2. Line up the stencil and hold it in place with washi tape and ink blend the outside frame (butterfly or fern) in the color of your choice.
- 3. Layer sentiment section of the stencil to the same card front, tape it down, and ink blend in the different color of your choice.
- 4. Ink blend the edges, about 0.5 inches in depth, of the back (larger) card layer in the color of your choice.
- 5. Fold the card base in half to make a 5.5 x 4.25 (A2) card.
- 6. Glue front (smaller) card layer to the back (larger) card layer, and glue combined layers to the card base.

Birthday Wishes Card



Supplies Used

- TCW6043 A2 Layered Hydrangea Banner Stencil
- TCW9066 Orchid Stencil Butter
- Catherine Pooler Lilac Ink
- Catherine Pooler Crushed Violet Ink
- Catherine Pooler Eucalyptus Ink

- (1) white A2 Card base and envelope
- (1) white 4.25 x 5.5 inch paper card layer (back)
- (1) white 4 x 5.25 inch paper card layer (front)
- (2) copy paper
- StyleTech Craft Matte Black "birthday wishes" in vinyl
- StyleTech Craft Transfer tape
- Sizzix Tape Runner
- Small paint scraper

Extra Supplies Needed

- Blending brushes
- Washi tape
- Bone folder (if desired)
- Palette knife
- Weeding tool
- Felt Edge Squeegee

Optional supplies

- Black ink
- TCW6036 Full Sheet of Good Words Stencils

Instructions

- 1. Tape down the front (smaller) card layer to the copy paper with washi tape.
- 2. Line up stencil section 2 with the paper, tape it down, and ink blend with the Lilac ink.
- 3. Line up stencil section 3 with the paper, tape it down, and ink blend with the Crushed Violet ink.
- 4. Line up stencil section 1 with the paper, tape it down, and ink blend with the Eucalyptus ink.
- 5. Line up stencil section 4 with the paper, tape it down, and using the small paint scraper or a palette knife apply the Orchid Stencil Butter.
- 6. Let the card front dry completely.
- 7. Place the back (large) card layer to the copy paper.
- 8. Apply Orchid Stencil Butter to the edges with the small paint scraper, about 0.5 inches in depth, of the back (larger) card layer and let it dry.
- 9. Weed out the out outer section and inside of the letters of the word "birthday wishes"
- 10. Apply transfer tape on top of the vinyl letters with the squeegee or your fingers, and pull up making sure all letters are stuck to the transfer tape
- 11. Line up the words in the center of the card in the "banner" section and transfer to the card with
- 12. Pull off the transfer tape leaving the vinyl words on the card.

- 13. (optional ink blending instead of vinyl) Using the Good words stencil pick out the phrase or words of your choice that fit into the space and ink blend with black in the banner section.
- 14. Fold the card base in half to make a 5.5 x 4.25 (A2) card.
- 15. Glue front (smaller) card layer to the back (larger) card layer, and glue combined layers to the card base.

Cutting Instructions (for Cricut)

- 1. Place vinyl colors and type of your choice liner side down onto StandardGrip Mat.
- 2. Select the "Birthday Wishes" SVG file into design space.
- 3. Size image to 4.8" wide by .5" tall and select "make it"
- 4. Select the vinyl setting for the type of vinyl you placed on your mat.
- 5. Load mat into the machine and press the flashing Go button.
