The Amazing World of Sublimation

Maker's Squad Tumbler



Supplies Provided in Kit

- Craft Express Tumbler and Straw
- "Makers Squad" Sublimation print
- 3 Artesprix Markers
- Copy Paper
- Protective Paper

Extra Supplies Needed

- Craft Express Tumbler Press
- Heat Tape
- Heat resistant gloves
- Artesprix Heat Pad
- Lint Roller

Optional supplies

- Rainbow of Artesprix Sublimation Markers

- Rainbow of Artesprix Inks
- Blending Brushes
- Various The Crafter's Workshop Stencils

Instructions

- 1. Use the lint roller to romove anything that might be stuck to the tumbler surface, like dust or fuzz. Remove the lid and straw
- 2. Tape down the Maker's Squad Sublimation Print to the tumbler with the image facing the tumbler
- 3. Wrap tumbler with protecvtive paper and tape in place.
- 4. Heat tumbler press to 350 400 F
- 5. Insert tumbler in the press and lock into place and heat set for 150 210 seconds
- 6. Remove tumbler from the press using heat resistant gloves and let cool completely on the heat pad
- 7. Once cool remove the protective paper, tape, and sublimation paper.

Optional Sublimation Design

- 1. Option 1 is to use copy paper and use Artesprix Sublimation Markers to draw a design and then follow steps 2 7 above.
- 2. Option 2 is to use The Crafter's Workshop stencil of choice, Artesprix Submilation Inks, and blending brushes to create a design on copy paper and then follow steps 2-7 above.

Makers gonna Make Tote Bag



Supplies Provided in Kit

- Tote Bag
- "Makers gonne Make" Sublimation print
- 3 Artesprix Markers
- Copy Paper
- Protective Paper

Extra Supplies Needed

- Craft Express Heat Press
- Heat Tape
- Heat resistant gloves
- Artesprix Heat Pad
- Lint Roller

Optional supplies

- Rainbow of Artesprix Sublimation Markers
- Rainbow of Artesprix Inks
- Blending Brushes
- Various The Crafter's Workshop Stencils

Instructions

- 1. Use the lint roller to romove anything that might be stuck to the tote surface, like dust or fuzz.
- 2. Place tote on top of the heat pad
- 3. Tape down the "Makers gonne Make" Sublimation Print to the tote with the image facing the tote.
- 4. Place a layer of protective paper over print image and tape in place
- 5. Heat up the Craft Express Heat Press to 380 420 F
- 6. Place heat press over tote and heat set for 35 40 seconds
- 7. Remove the press let the tote cool completely on the heat pad
- 8. Once cool remove the protective paper, tape, and sublimation paper.

Optional Sublimation Design

- 1. Option 1 is to use copy paper and use Artesprix Sublimation Markers to draw a design and then follow steps 2 7 above.
- 2. Option 2 is to use The Crafter's Workshop stencil of choice, Artesprix Submilation Inks, and blending brushes to create a design on copy paper and then follow steps 2-7 above.
